- Choose between a variety of providers: WEDnet, third-party or in-house staff
- Choose how/where to receive training: onsite, offsite, or online
- Determine if <u>eligible</u>, then complete online application and MOA, then turn in a training plan to request funds

• Training Plan: submit your own. Must have one created to begin the WEDnet process, can go back and edit after if needed
